REASONS TO CALL THE BURLINGTON POLICE DEPARTMENT

Give your name, address and phone number.

Describe why you are calling.

Pay attention to clothing, height and other physical details.

- Illegal behavior in or around my business.
- I feel unsafe for myself or others because someone is being aggressive or engaging in threatening behavior.
- A shoplifter is still in my store or has left my store with merchandise.
- Individuals are fighting in or around my business.
- My business has prepared a trespass notice for an individual. I need assistance from BPD to deliver my trespass notice.
- Someone is impaired by drugs or alcohol or appears to be experiencing a mental health crisis and I am concerned for their safety or the safety of others.
